

How to get to the ANIMATAS Bremen 2018 Winter School

- **From Bremen Airport**

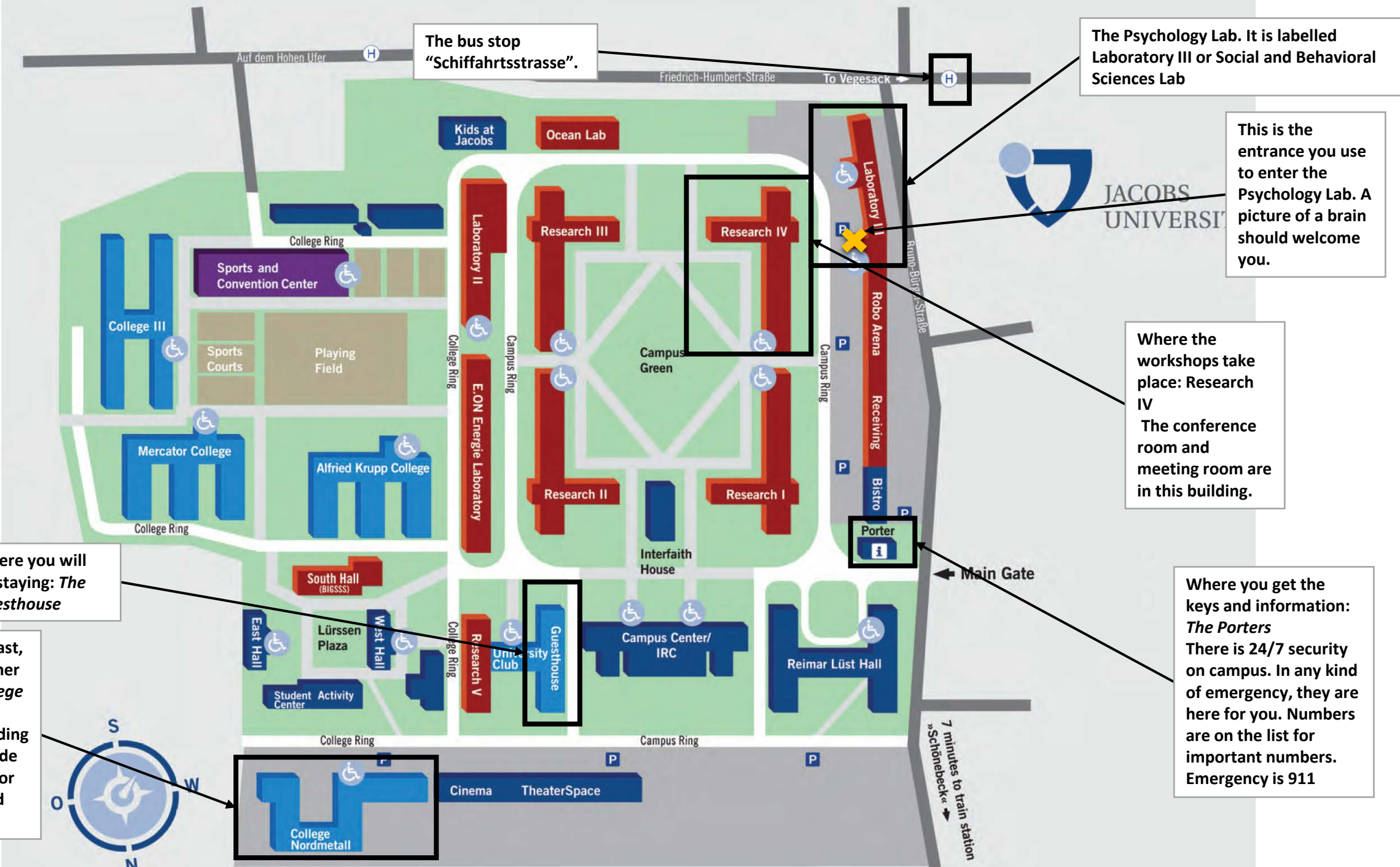
- As you exit the Bremen Airport, you will find the tram stop right in front of you.
- You will need to buy a ticket at the **ticket machine**. The machine has the option for English as well, simply press on the British flag. Choose **Bremen-Schönebeck** as your destination. An adult ticket should cost €2.85. This ticket will allow you to travel all the way to Jacobs University Bremen (including both tram and train).
- Take the **number 6 tram** in the direction **Universität**. Once you get on the tram, you will need to validate your ticket in one of the machines on the tram.

- **From HBF/Central Station**

- Get off at **HBF/Central Station** (approximately 25 minutes from the airport). The tram stops in front of the Central Station. The entrance to the HBF will be behind a mini Christmas market. Once inside the HBF, you will see billboards overhead where the trains are listed. You can take any train on line **RS1** that goes to **Bremen-Farge** or **Bremen-Vegesack**. They usually leave every half an hour at xx:04 or xx:34, and in peak hours every 15 minutes at xx:19 or xx:49. Check the platform on the billboards – they normally depart from platform 5 or 6. Before you enter the train on the platform, make sure it says Bremen-Farge or Bremen-Vegesack on the train. Sometimes the RS1 train going in the opposite direction leaves shortly before the ones towards Vegesack.
- The ticket you bought at the Airport ticket machine is still valid for the train; you do not need to validate it again. Travel with the train until **Bremen-Schönebeck** (6 stops).
- From here on you may refer to the **map of Bremen Nord** (attached) for visualization:

- **From Schönebeck Train Station**

- At **Schönebeck**, follow the stairs up to the bridge. On the bridge, turn right and go along the street, following a slight left curve. After some minutes you should notice the campus on the left, with glass fences, which say *Welcome* in many different languages. You will know you have reached the main gate when you see the gate where cars can pass and it says Jacobs University in silver letters on the wall. On the right side of the entrance, is a little office, where the security and porters are located. Here you can ask for your keys.

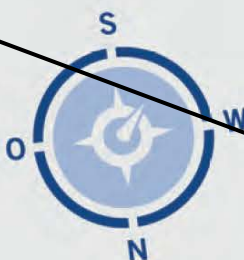

This is the train station towards city center..

In order to get to campus from the Bremen Schönebeck station, you get up the stairs at the station and take a right on the bridge. You then follow the street, which take a little curve to the left until you see the university on the left hand side. There is a main gate in silver, where you enter.

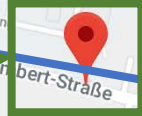
This is the closest bus station to campus. It is called "Taunusstraße". The bus can take you to Vegesack or to Lesum. Some stops away, there is a super market called "netto". The bus station is called "Schönebecker Straße". The opening hours are Mondays through Saturdays 7am until 9pm.



This is a gas station. They can provide you with some snacks and drinks, in case of late night cravings and empty vending machines. The opening hours are Monday-Friday from 5am until 11pm, on Saturdays from 6am until 11pm and Sundays 7am until 11 pm.
